Applications for SDGs grants are to be returned by September 1 (or the following business day if September 1 falls on a weekend) on a printout or photocopy of these forms. Approved projects will be notified following favorable Bishop and Council action.

Those who receive grants are accountable for ensuring the funds are used for the purposes described in their application, and an evaluation describing the actual use of the funds is due to the Opportunity Fund committee by September 1 of the following year.
